





Fell Swoop



MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: PurlWise by All You Knit is Love – 180grs

total

Gauge: 15 sts x 30 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{cm}$ in garter

stitch

Needles: 4.0mm circulars 100cm cable

Notions: Tapestry needle Finished size: 60cm x 250cm While I love asymmetrical shawls, most are knit end to end and I found that I missed the Vshaped stripes that come from a top-down structure. This shawl was designed to satisfy that particular craving of mine

Pick your colors, plan your stripes -or don't-

and knit up a storm!

TIPS

- On RS rows, the yarn over from the previous row counts as one of the last 3 sts.
- The dropped yarn over at the end of each RS row creates a lengthened stitch along the top edge of the shawl. This makes it stretchier and easier to block out.
- Make your stripes uniform or random...it's all up to you!



ABBREVIATIONS

WS = wrong side RS = right side K = knit P = purl

sm = slip marker kfb = knit front and back sl1wyif = slip 1 stitch with the yarn in front

pm = place marker

INSTRUCTIONS

yo = yarn over

CO 6 sts

Set-up Rows (work once)

a (WS): K1, yo, k2, pm, p1, k2

b (RS): K1, yo, kfb, k1, sm, kfb, kfb, drop yo, k1

c: k1, yo, kfb, k to marker, sm, p1, k to last 2 sts, drop yo, k1

Body

1 (RS): sllwyif, k to marker, sm, kfb, k to last 3 sts, kfb, drop yo, k1.

2, 4, 6, 8 (WS): k1, yo, kfb, k to marker, sm, p1, k to end.

3: slīwyif, kfb, k to 2 sts before marker, kfb, kī, sm, kfb, k to last 3 sts, kfb, drop yo, kī.

5: slīwyif, k to marker, sm, kfb, k to last 3 sts, kfb, drop yo, kī.

7: slīwyif, k to 2 sts before marker, kfb, kī, sm, kfb, k to last 3 sts, kfb, drop yo, kī.

Repeat these 8 rows, changing colors as you like, until you have 344 sts in total.

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Bind off as follows: *k2, go into the front of those 2 stitches with the left needle and knit them together, pass the resulting stitch back on to the left needle*, rep from * to * until 2 stitches remain, k2, go into the front of those 2 stitches with the left needle and knit them together.



FINISHING

Weave in ends. Soak in lukewarm water for 15-20 minutes (or machine wash on gentle cycle) and block to the desired measurements.



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
